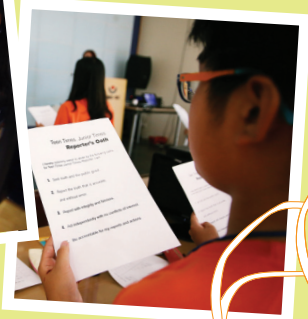

On June 29, MBC's Documentary Special aired about captain Kim Seung-jin. He succeeded in completing his world travels in 6 months on a non-powered yacht. Now, he is the sixth person in the world and the first person in Korea to hold this record.

In 2001, Kim Seung-jin, who worked in New Zealand as a documentary producer, became interested in boating. In 2010, he bought a yacht with all his savings. Finally, on Oct. 19, 2014,

he started traveling as an ocean adventurer. He departed from the Waemok Port in South Chungcheong Province. Sunda Strait, which is located in Indonesia, is known for dangerous pirates, but he safely passed the ocean due to his great judgment and the efforts of land support staff.
